

STAB STITCH BINDING INNER PAGE SETUP

Please check our guide to ensure that your pages are setup correctly before sending them for print.
If you do not leave enough binding margin or safe areas it could result in something important getting clipped or trimmed off.

3mm Bleed Area

"Bleed" is the area that will be trimmed off after the job is printed and cut down to the finished size.
Fill the background image (if you have one) to the bleed area.

10mm Safe Area

We recommend keeping any page numbers, text etc... 10mm away from the edges of your finished page size.

Remember to make sure any important parts of your design fall inside of the Safe Area.

Minimum 20mm Binding Margin

"Binding Margin" is the area that needs to be taken into account for binding.
We recommend keeping any page numbers, text etc... at least 20mm away from the binding edge of your finished page size.

PLEASE NOTE:

For double sided/Duplex printed books you will need to mirror your margins - please see example diagram

You need to save/export your document as a single page PDF (not spreads) with crop and bleed marks (if applicable).
